ITINERARY HIGHLIGHTS | JUNE 17 - 26, 2026

Day 1.

Departure USA/Ireland

Depart USA for your overnight flight to Dublin. Meals will be served on board.

Day 2 –

Welcome to Ireland.

Arrive at Dublin airport and meet your Driver and Guide and depart for Westport. En route visit Clonmacnoise, a wonderful early Christian site founded by St. Ciarán in the mid-6th century on the eastern bank of the River Shannon. In a stunning setting, the site includes the ruins of a cathedral, seven churches (10th–13th century), two round towers, three high crosses and the largest collection of early Christian grave slabs in Western Europe. The original high crosses and a selection of grave slabs are on display in the visitor centre. Upon our arrival in Westport, enjoy an orientation tour of the town, followed by free time to explore at your own pace. Nestled between Clew Bay and the majestic Croagh Patrick mountain, Westport is a charming heritage town known for its colourful Georgian streets, traditional Irish pubs, and lively atmosphere. You may choose to stroll along the scenic Carrowbeg River, enjoy local artisan shops, or relax in one of the many cosy cafés and restaurants. Continue to our hotel for time at leisure. Dinner and overnight at the Westport Castlecourt hotel



Day 3 –

Kylemore Abbey or Ballintubber Abbey and Galway

After breakfast, enjoy a full day exploring the beauty and heritage of the west of Ireland. Today you can choose between two excursion options:

Option 1: Visit Kylemore Abbey

Travel through the stunning Connemara region, known for its rugged landscapes, stone walls, and shimmering lakes. Arrive at Kylemore Abbey, a romantic neo-Gothic castle nestled on the shores of a tranquil lake at the foot of a mountain. Discover the fascinating history of the Benedictine nuns, stroll through the restored rooms of the Abbey, and enjoy the beauty of the Victorian Walled Gardens. Return to Westport for dinner and overnight at the hotel.



Option 2: Visit Ballintubber Abbey and Galway

Begin the day with a visit to Ballintubber Abbey, founded in 1216 and still in use today. It is often referred to as "the Abbey that refused to die" and has been a place of continuous worship for over 800 years. After the visit, continue to Galway, a vibrant city on Ireland's west coast. Enjoy a guided walking tour through its colourful streets, discovering landmarks such as Eyre Square, the Spanish Arch, and St. Nicholas' Collegiate Church. There will be time for lunch and to explore the city at your own pace. Return to Westport for dinner and overnight at the hotel.



Day 4 –

Galway – Limerick

After breakfast and check-out, depart Westport and travel south through the scenic landscapes of County Clare. In the morning, enjoy a visit to The Burren, a unique karst limestone region known for its lunar-like landscape, rich archaeological heritage, and remarkable biodiversity. Embark on a guided walking tour to explore this otherworldly environment, where Arctic, Mediterranean, and Alpine plants grow side by side. Then, visit the Burren Centre in Kilfenora, which offers an engaging introduction to the geology, history, and culture of the region through interactive exhibits and audiovisual presentations.

In the afternoon, continue to the spectacular Cliffs of Moher, one of Ireland's most iconic natural landmarks. Standing 214 meters at their highest point and stretching 8 kilometres along the Atlantic coast, the cliffs offer breathtaking views over the ocean and the Aran Islands. There will be time to walk along the cliff paths and visit the visitor centre. After the visit, continue to Limerick. Dinner and overnight at Radisson Blu Hotel.



Day 5 –

Limerick to Killarney

This morning, enjoy a panoramic tour of Limerick. Visit St. Mary's Cathedral. St. Mary's Cathedral is Limerick City's oldest church. It began as a palace, and some parts of the original building still stand. A mixture of Romanesque and Gothic styles, the majority of the present-day structure survives from the restoration of the building in 1580. Then we visit King John Castle situated on "King's Island" in the heart of medieval Limerick City. The Castle overlooks the majestic river Shannon. Depart Limerick and travel to Killarney. Dinner and overnight at Randles Hotel, Killarney.

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Day 6 –

Ring of Kerry

We set off on an exciting day after breakfast embarking on the Ring of Kerry. The Ring of Kerry is the most famous and panoramic route in Ireland. The astonishing beauty of this large peninsula, Iveragh, comes from the great diversity of its scenery, which offers incessant contrasts. En route around the Ring, take in spectacular scenery – mountains, peat bogs, lakes and magnificent views of the Atlantic Ocean as one travels along the coast road. Upon our return to Killarney enjoy a traditional afternoon tea at the 5-star Muckross Park Hotel. Traditional Irish night at Kate Kearney's Cottage with dinner and Irish show. Overnight at Randles Hotel, Killarney,



Day 7 –

Killarney to Waterford

After breakfast and check-out, depart Killarney and journey eastward toward Waterford. En route, stop to visit the remarkable Rock of Cashel, one of Ireland's most significant heritage sites. Perched on a limestone outcrop rising above the surrounding plains, the Rock of Cashel is an ancient royal site and ecclesiastical centre that offers a powerful insight into Ireland's early Christian history. The site features a collection of medieval buildings including a round tower, a Gothic cathedral, and Cormac's Chapel with its remarkable Romanesque architecture and frescoes. This site is especially meaningful for those interested in the roots of Christian tradition and its evolution through the centuries. The Rock of Cashel stands as a symbol of the intersection between spiritual authority and historical power, providing a deeper understanding of the religious transformations that have shaped Europe's faith heritage. Continue to Waterford, Ireland's oldest city, founded by Vikings in 914 AD. In the afternoon, enjoy a visit to the House of Waterford Crystal, where you'll experience a fascinating guided factory tour that reveals the intricate craftsmanship behind the world-famous crystal pieces. Witness skilled artisans at work and browse the exquisite showroom. Dinner and overnight at the Marina Waterford Hotel.



Day 8 –

Waterford to Dublin

Following breakfast, depart Waterford and travel to Dublin via Wicklow. We visit the Glendalough Visitor Centre. Set in a glaciated valley with two lakes, the monastic remains include a superb round tower, stone churches and decorated crosses. Journey on into the Wicklow Mountains. Discover the romantic and quiet beauty of County Wicklow, the deserted mounts where nothing but heather grows, the small forests and the lush prairies illuminated by yellow gorse in spring. Continue to Dublin and check in to your hotel. Dinner and overnight at Iveagh Garden Hotel.



Day 9 –

Dublin Fair City

Today we enjoy a panoramic Dublin City Tour. We visit the north and south side of the River Liffey. This area offers great striking monuments such as the GPO (General Post Office) on the city main thoroughfare, O'Connell Street, or the Custom House along the quays, as well as the Phoenix Park, the largest public park in Europe. The south side appears more sophisticated with its vast Georgian squares, such as Merrion Square, where Oscar Wilde's House can still be found (today owned by an American College), its colourful doors, along with Grafton Street and its quality shops. Not so far from St. Stephen's Green, in Kildare St., you will see the house of Bram Stoker, the author of Dracula. This part of the city is also dominated by the students of Trinity College, where we will visit the famous book of Kells which is permanently exhibited in its library. We visit St. Patrick's Cathedral, the National Cathedral of the Church of Ireland (a church of the Anglican communion). St Patrick's is Gothic in style and its splendid interior is adorned with funeral monuments, such as The Boyle Family Memorial and the grave of Dean Jonathan Swift (author of Gulliver's Travels). Swift was dean here until his death in 1745. The Chancel has ornate stained-glass windows, and spectacular choir stalls, once used by the knights of St Patrick, adjoin the Altar. The massive west towers, houses a large peal of bells whose ringing tones are so much part of the character of Dublin. Enjoy the afternoon at leisure in the city centre. We recommend a stroll down Grafton Street where you can enjoy the best in street entertainment. The shopping is also great in this area of the city! Dinner and overnight at Iveagh Garden Hotel, Dublin.



Day 10 –

Departure - USA.

After a final farewell breakfast at your hotel, transfer to Dublin airport for your departure flight.
