

MYLIE NEEL is graduating from Reeths-Puffer High School. She plans to attend college and eventually work in accounting and finance.


CADE PAUGH is graduating from Reeths-Puffer. He plans to attend Central Michigan University.


KARLEY PLEKES is graduating from Holton High School. She plans to attend Western Michigan University, where she plans to study business law.
